

## RESOLUTION NO. 2012-010

A RESOLUTION of the Commission of Public Utility District No. 1 of Jefferson County, Washington, amending Resolution No. 2008-003 to change the interest rate on the assessments for Local Utility District No. 15.

WHEREAS, Public Utility District No. 1 of Jefferson County, Washington (the "District") created Local Utility District No. 15 ("LUD No. 15") by Resolution No. 2005-008 and provided for the issuance of bonds to pay the cost of improvements in the District and expenses incidental thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Commission of the District adopted Resolution No. 2008-003, authorizing the issuance and sale of its Revenue Bond, 2008 (Local Improvement District No. 15) (the "Bond") in the aggregate principal amount of \$1,053,076 to First Federal Savings and Loan Association of Port Angeles (the "Bank") to provide funds to pay for part of the costs of the improvements constructed in LUD No. 15, repaying interim financing for LUD No. 15 and paying costs of issuing the Bond; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 08-001, passed on February 29, 2008, the District assessed the amount of \$2,750,000, which was amended to \$2,650,000 for the improvements and related costs for LUD No. 15, of which \$648,000 was paid during the 30-day prepayment period; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2008-003, the District assessed the remaining \$2,008,000 to the property in LUD No. 15 to be paid in 15 equal annual installments at a per annum rate of 2.25%; and

WHEREAS, based on the remaining amount owed on the Bond, and the assessments collected and to be collected, it is in the best interest of the District and the property owners in LUD No. 15 to lower the interest rate of the assessments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission of Public Utility District No. 1 of Jefferson County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. Change to Assessment Rate. The District shall direct the Treasurer of Jefferson County, as ex officio treasurer of the District (the "Treasurer"), to change the interest rate of the assessments owed in LUD No. 15 to 2.10% from 2.25%.


All other provisions of Resolution No. 2008-003 shall remain unchanged.


Section 2. General Authorization. The District's Manager and Treasurer are authorized to take any action necessary to implement this resolution.


Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be in effect from and after its adoption in accordance with law.


**CERTIFICATION**
